ENERGY STAR APPLIANCE REBATE



Eligibility

The Appliance must have an ENERGY STAR rating and be installed in a permanent residence receiving service from Central Electric Cooperative (CEC). For clothes washer and dishwasher rebates, an electric water heater is required.

Easy Steps

- 1.** Purchase an eligible ENERGY STAR clothes washer, dishwasher, refrigerator, or freezer. Your retailer should have a list of qualifying brands and model numbers or you can look at a list of ENERGY STAR models at www.energystar.gov.
- 2.** Complete, sign, and submit the rebate application. Don't forget to include your sales receipt (copies are acceptable) listing the brand and model number of the appliance(s).

- 4.** Your application will be processed within 30 days.

Save Energy, Save Money
